Expert teachers will, on their return, implement the pilot testing (P2) for 2 Integrated Lessons - result of Module 4 – Mathematical Literacy; Conduct surveys and assessment; Cooperate and work on future **Integrated curriculum** as one of the major Project Outcome.

Partners teams of teachers (expert teachers from C8 together with their school colleagues) will:

- Carry on the piloting activities
- Collect relevant data
- Conduct evaluation among the students and other subject teachers
- Make presentations (graphs, charts etc.) in order to present the Project results so that they can be well disseminated on eTwinning
